Stock is well established, canned azaleas with genuine potential. Once the plants have been roughed out, they will be clearly marked, then "grown on" over the summer at Keith's: watered, weeded, sprayed and fertilized to provide optimum growth for further refining and potting at the September 21th Meeting.
